Bee a Shabbastic Student

Milk and Honey

In Hebrew, there is a play on the word *deborah*, which means "a bee," with Judge Deborah, a righteous judge in Israel. Her name is *Deborah* in Hebrew. Under Deborah's Godly government, Israel enjoyed forty years of peace. *Debor*, the root of both bee and Deborah, means "word" in Hebrew. The lesson of the bee? Being diligent in the Word produces Shabbastic peace in the Word.

In the wilderness, Moses promised the people that Israel was a special Land flowing with milk and honey. The Israelites complained that Moses had NOT brought them to a Land flowing with milk and honey. Instead, they said that Egypt was the land flowing with milk and honey.

The Israelites missed the spiritual bread by looking for physical manna, and they missed the spiritual drink by demanding physical water. These were prophecies of Yeshua. The Israelites missed the prophecies of bread and water, so they missed the prophecy of the milk and honey. It was the spiritual Word of the Torah preached to them in the wilderness.

Write on them all the words of this law [Torah] when you cross over, so that you may enter the land which the LORD your God gives you, a land flowing with milk and honey, as the LORD, the God of your fathers, promised you.

Recipe for a Shabbastic Shabbat

Being new to Shabbat is both exciting and perplexing. Once a person decides to observe the Shabbat, the next question is, "But how do I?" Exodus 16:32 provides good beginner instructions:

This is what the LORD meant: tomorrow is a sabbath observance, a holy sabbath to the LORD. Bake what you will bake and boil what you will boil, and all that is left over put aside to be kept until morning.

Does this mean I can't cook on Shabbat? Pretty much. And no grilling, either, because Israel is not to kindle fire on Shabbat.

You shall not kindle a fire in any of your dwellings on the sabbath day.¹

Here's an Israeli expression you can use whenever the instructions of the Torah stump you: "Oy vey!" So what's the play, you ask? That's exactly it: make a plan each week. A Shabbat plan is a recipe for success. A Shabbastic plan takes you from "Oy vey!" to "Oh, boy!"

Shabbastic Garden of Eatin'

Something wonderful happens "in the land of the evening" on Friday evening. Think of Shabbat as family garden, and like the first family, Adam and Eve, the Creator has put you and your family there to beautify it.

The Creator already planned the eternal trees to feature in a Shabbastic garden. Engagement of the day, the business of the day, and to kindle a fire on the day, not to work at your occupation on the day, and not to buy and sell on the day.² The "hot" trees in the garden protect one's ability to enjoy the day and make them like the Creator does.

Let's think about the great trees of engagement and holiness in this Shabbastic garden and what will bring out its beauty in the home.

We'll start with the Holy Spirit. But as for you, speak to the sons of Israel, saying, "You shall surely observe My sabbaths, for this is a sign between Me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that I am the LORD who sanctifies you. Therefore, you are to observe the sabbath, for it is holy to you." (Ex 31:12-17)

Holiness means to set apart with the idea of gathering the set apart thing to things of like kind. The Holy One sanctifies His people with Shabbat and makes them holy. The garden used as a holy station to master where they live "from the rising of the sun until the going down of the sun." It's a holy place for husband and wife, apart from all others, but gathered to love. Shabbat is a place for like-minded people to gather, and it starts at home, so let's prepare landscaping in our garden that will beautify it with growing holiness and engagement.

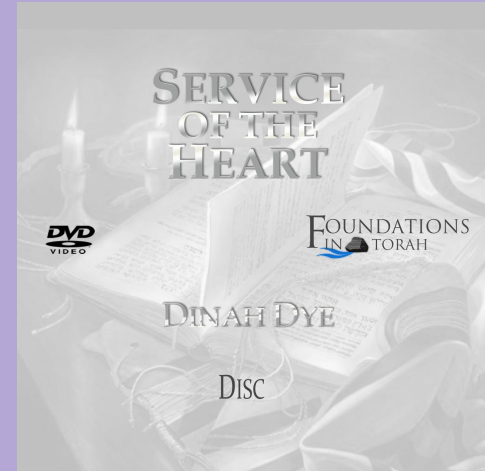
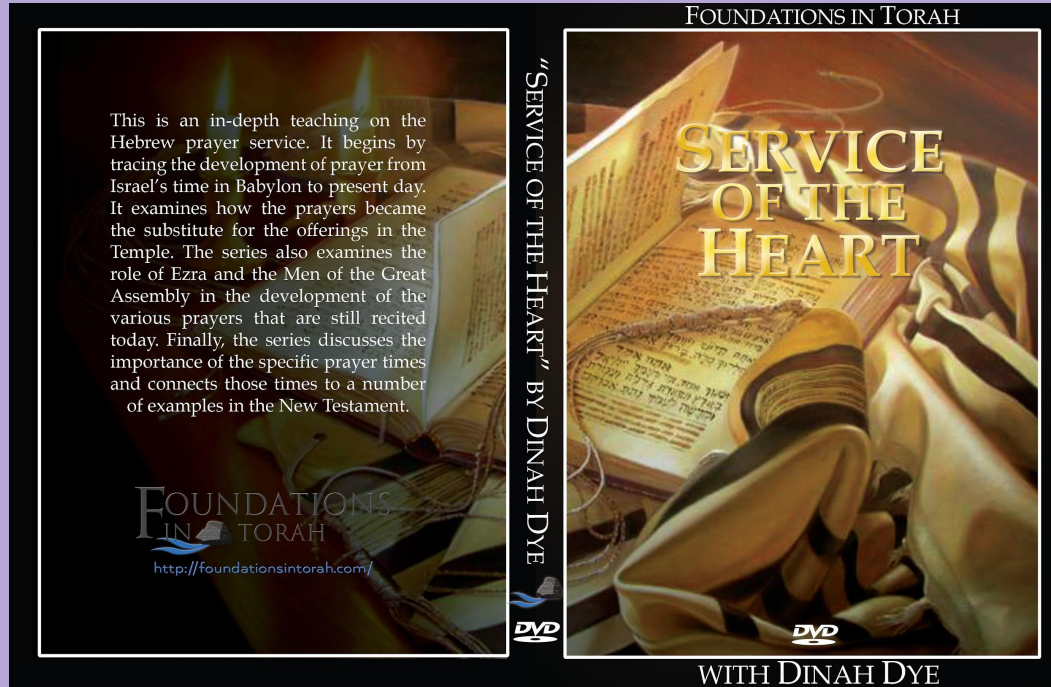
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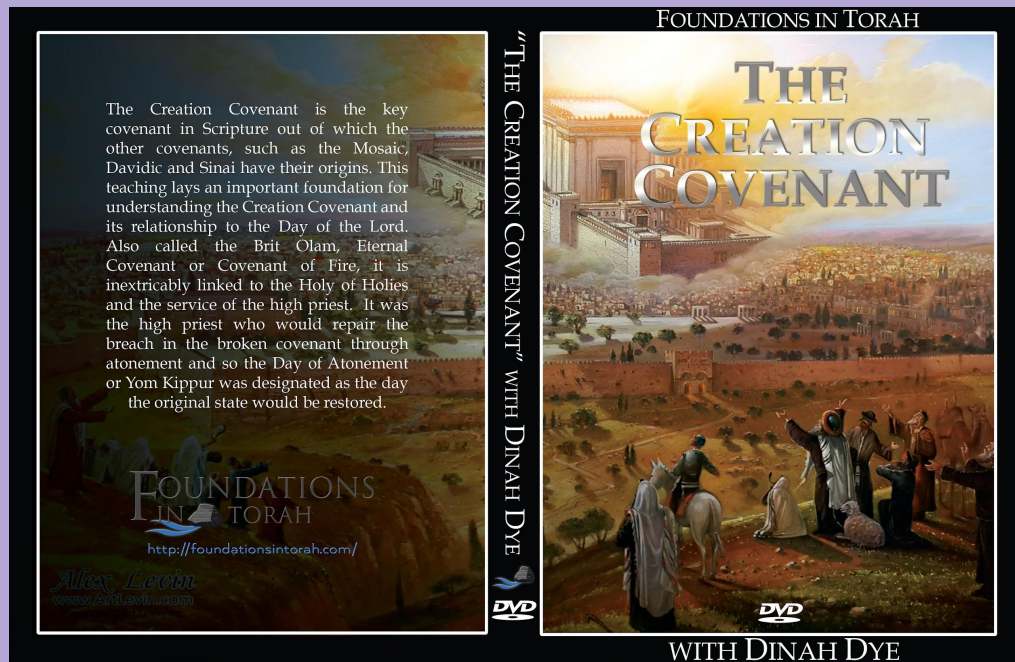
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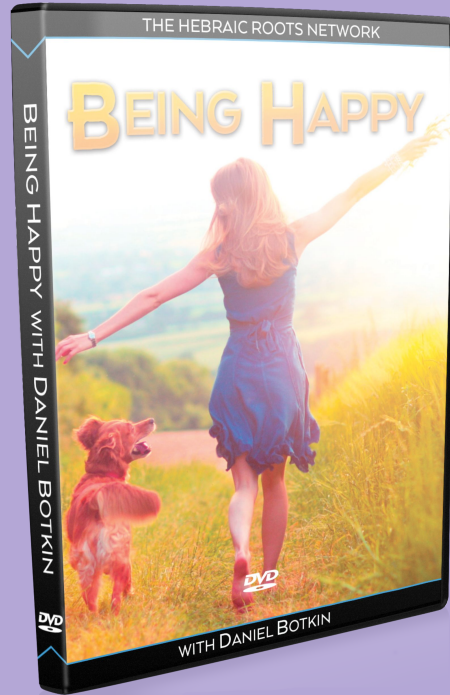
